2008 NOTES

-- UNH football is looking to advance to the NCAA Championships for an unprecedented fifth straight year after playing in the first round in 2007.

-- The biggest question this season for UNH is who will fill the shoes of All-American QB Ricky Santos. The frontrunners for the job will be sophomore R.J. Toman, who saw limited time last season when Santos suffered a shoulder injury. In addition, red-shirt freshman QB Kevin Decker has shown signs of being a good one with his strong arm.

-- UNH has won its last three FBS games over the likes of Marshall, Northwestern and Rutgers and will be looking to make it No. 4 in a row when the team travels to take on Army on Sept. 6.

-- UNH had coach Sean McDonnell, entering his 10th season as the head coach of UNH, has posted an amazing four-year record of 37-14. His overall mark is a winning 60-46-0.

-- UNH returns a great deal of experience on its offensive line in 2008 with four seniors and a junior expected to start. The five starters average 296.0 pounds between them. All but one of the seniors have seen time on the line as a starter.

-- UNH has brought in a transfer QB from Mississippi State named Kyle Auffray, who is originally from Cornwall, N.Y. He is a junior in eligibility. He will compete with several QBs, including frontrunners R.J. Toman and Kevin Decker. He did not see any playing time with the Bulldogs.

-- Boyle also was a capable runner, with three carries for 80 yds and two TDs.

-- The team's returning punt returner, Boyle had eight punt returns for 50 yards.



CHAD KACKERT
Junior - Running Back
5-8 - 190 - Simi Valley, Calif.

-- UNH's top running back last season, Kackert carried the football 80 times for 380 yards, averaging 4.8 yards per carry.

-- Kackert was tied for second in rushing TDs with four on the season and also caught 20 passes for 196 yds and two TDs and was third on the team in total offense.

-- He also serves as UNH's starting kick returner. Last year he returned 20 kicks for 525 yards and one TD. He averaged an impressive mark of 26.3 yards per return.
