Germain was involved in all five Delaware goals last weekend with a goal and four assists as the Blue Hens won a pair of CAA games. In a 2-0 triumph over Towson, the junior forward scored the game-winning goal and assisted on an insurance tally. She then picked up assists on all three goals as UD blanked George Mason 3-0. For the season, Germain tops the Hens with 11 points on three goals and five assists.

## CONFERENCE NOTES:

**ODU, Hofstra Tied Atop CAA Standings:** With just three league games remaining, the race for the CAA regular-season title and a spot in the CAA Tournament field remains tight. **Old Dominion** and **Hofstra** each won twice last week and are now tied for first place with 19 points (6-1-1). **James Madison** and **William & Mary** are right behind with 18 points (6-2) and **UNC Wilmington** is fifth with 15 points. **VCU** holds the sixth spot with 13 points, but three teams are within four points of the Rams for the final tourney spot.

**ODU Ranked #28 By Soccer Buzz:** **Old Dominion** is ranked #28 in the nation this week by *Soccer Buzz*. Five CAA teams are ranked regionally this week by the NSCAA and *Soccer Buzz* in their Oct. 20 polls. In the NSCAA Mid-Atlantic region poll, **James Madison** is tied for #3, **Old Dominion** is #6 and **William & Mary** is tied for #7, while in the Northeast region, **Hofstra** is ranked #4. In the *Soccer Buzz* Mid-Atlantic poll, ODU is #5, JMU is #8, W&M is #9 and **VCU** is #15. Hofstra is #4 in the Northeast.

**Gonzales Chosen As Finalist For Lowe' Senior CLASS Award:** Georgia State senior **Candace Gonzales** is one of 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The award honors student-athletes who make a positive impact through athletics. Gonzales ranks among the top 7% of her academic class and is also heavily involved in community service projects.

**Six Teams In Top 90 Of NCAA RPI:** Six CAA women's soccer teams were ranked among the top 90 in the first NCAA RPI report released on Oct. 7. **Old Dominion** led all CAA squads at #27, followed closely by **William & Mary** at #30 and **James Madison** at #31. **UNC Wilmington** was at #50, **Hofstra** was at #68 and **VCU** was at #90.

**Harbrueger Among Top Scorers:** Georgia State's **Kay Harbrueger** ranked second in the nation in points per game (2.57) and third in goals per game (1.07) according to the latest NCAA stats through games of Oct. 12. JMU's **Teresa Rynier** ranks 10th (0.71 apg) and VCU's **Stephanie Power** were 12th (0.67 apg) in assists per game, while ODU keeper **Lauren Tupman** was 24th in GAA (0.575).

**DELAWARE (6-8-1 overall, 3-5 in CAA):**

The Blue Hens climbed into contention for a CAA Tournament spot after wins over Towson (2-0) and George Mason (3-0) last week. Junior forward **Caitlyn Germain** was involved in all five Delaware scores, recording the game-winning goal and an assist versus Towson and then assisting on all three goals versus Mason. Senior **Alli D'Amico** also had a big weekend with a goal and three assists. Germain and D'Amico are tied for the team lead with 11 points. Also scoring goals for UD over the weekend were **Jess Bendzlowicz**, **Amy Pickard** and **Ilyssa Friedman**. Keeper **Annie Bevan** made four saves and earned her fourth shutout versus TU, while **Breanna Stemler** stopped five shots and got her second shutout against Mason. UD is at Georgia State and UNCW this week.

**DREXEL (6-9-1 overall, 1-6-1 in CAA):**

The Dragons earned four points last week, tying George Mason 1-1 before pulling out a 3-2 double-overtime victory against Towson. Freshman forward **Jenna Lindsay** scored the game-tying goal against Towson with 8:13 left in regulation and then netted the game-winner in the second overtime. Lindsay set Drexel records for goals (10) and game-winning goals (4) in a season. Junior midfielder **Carly Snyder** became the first Drexel player to record three assists in a game when she accomplished the feat versus Towson. Snyder has six assists on the

season, which ties a school record. **Jourdan Halasz** had the lone Dragons' goal versus Mason. Drexel visits UNCW and Georgia State this weekend.

**GEORGE MASON (4-11-1 overall, 1-6-1 in CAA):**

The Patriots rallied for a 1-1 tie at Drexel last Friday, but were beaten 3-0 at Delaware on Sunday. Mason fell behind Drexel 1-0 with four minutes to go, but junior forward **Kelly Keelan** scored her team-leading seventh goal of the season to tie the match with 2:51 remaining. Keelan is closing in on the top 15 in Patriots' history in goals and points. Goalkeeper **Melissa Mailley** made eight saves against the Dragons and stopped three shots in the loss at Delaware. Mason was only out-shot 12-11 by the Hens, but couldn't overcome an early deficit. The Patriots host William & Mary and Old Dominion this weekend.

**GEORGIA STATE (10-7 overall, 3-5 in CAA):**

The Panthers suffered a pair of losses on the road, falling 3-0 at Northeastern and 4-3 at Hofstra. Senior forward **Kay Harbrueger** continued her incredible season offensively, contributing two goals and an assist at Hofstra. She twice tied the game, including a goal that made it 3-3 with under 10 minutes remaining. Harbrueger leads the CAA in goals (17) and points (41) by a wide margin this season and she moved into third place on the Panthers' career goals list with 33. State also got a goal and two assists versus the Pride from senior **Caroline Harvischak**. Keeper **Heidi Blankenship** made 15 saves in the two games. State returns home to face Delaware and Drexel this week.

**HOFSTRA (9-5-2 overall, 6-1-1 in CAA):**

The Pride moved into a tie for first place after wins over UNC Wilmington (2-0) and Georgia State (4-3) last week. Sophomore forward **Salma Tarik** scored a goal in each match and moved into a tie for the team lead with four goals this season. **Marie Curtin** tacked on an insurance goal versus UNCW on a penalty kick and keeper **Krystal Robens** posted her seventh shutout. It was the Pride's 12th shutout in their last 13 contests against CAA foes. Freshman midfielder **Courtney Breen** scored the game-winning goal versus GSU with 7:24 left in regulation. It was the first time since 2000 that Hofstra had won a game when allowing three goals. **Kayla Pifer** and **Dana Bergstrom** also scored against the Panthers. Hofstra faces tough road tests at VCU and JMU this weekend.

**JAMES MADISON (10-4-2 overall, 6-2 in CAA):**

The Dukes dropped a 2-1 overtime decision at Old Dominion, but bounced back to edge William & Mary 1-0 in double-overtime. The victory kept JMU just a point out of first place. Junior midfielder **Corky Julien** gave the Dukes a 1-0 lead on ODU in the 61st minute and then netted the game-winner at W&M with 2:27 left in the second overtime. Julien has tied a JMU record by scoring in six consecutive matches and ranks second in the CAA with 11 goals. She is also 10th in career goals (25) and points (60) at JMU. Sophomore keeper **Diane Wszalek** saw her shutout streak end at 501:44 against ODU, but then made five saves at W&M to record her fourth shutout of the year. Sophomore **Teresa Rynier** picked up her league-leading 11th assist at ODU, which is one shy of the school record. The Dukes host key matches with Northeastern and Hofstra this weekend.

**UNC WILMINGTON (9-6-1 overall, 5-3 in CAA):**

The Seahawks split a pair of road matches, losing 2-0 at Hofstra before defeating Northeastern 2-1. UNCW got first-half goals from senior **Sarah Matthews** and sophomore **Tandy Banks** at NU and then held on for the win. Matthews has scored goals in four of her last seven games, while Banks found the net for the first time this season. Freshman keeper **Chandler Follett** made a career-high nine saves against the Huskies and stopped four shots at Hofstra where the Seahawks were out-shot 19-5. UNCW returns home this weekend to meet Drexel and Delaware.

**NORTHEASTERN (8-7-1 overall, 4-4 in CAA):**

The Huskies topped Georgia State 3-0 but then fell 2-1 to UNC Wilmington in their home finale. Senior forward **Jenna Lucchesi's** first goal of the season was the game-winner against GSU and she added her second goal in the second half versus UNCW to cut the NU deficit to one. Freshman forward **Veronica Napoli** contributed two goals and an assist in the win over State and also picked up an assist against UNCW. Napoli ranks second in the CAA with 25 points (10g, 5a) and her 10 goals this season are more than NU scored as a team in 2007. Keeper **Stephanie Gordon** made four saves against GSU and earned her fourth shutout of the year. The Huskies visit JMU and VCU this weekend.

**OLD DOMINION (13-2-1 overall, 6-1-1 in CAA):**

The Lady Monarchs moved into a tie for first place after impressive home wins over James Madison (2-1 in OT) and VCU (3-0). ODU improved to 8-0-1 at home and has out-scored foes 28-1 in Norfolk this year. Senior **Shavon Knight** assisted on the game-tying goal by **Ashley Kukura** with 3:29 left versus JMU and then recorded her fourth game-winner of the season in overtime. Knight tops the Lady Monarchs with 25 points (9g, 7a). **Victoria Johnson** scored her seventh goal of the year against VCU and gave ODU three 20-point scorers for the first time in school history. Senior defender **Marilee Mastaler** netted her first career goal against VCU and **Janna Pearson** scored her first goal of the season. ODU travels to Towson and George Mason this weekend.

**TOWSON (3-12-1 overall, 0-7-1 in CAA):**

The Tigers have dropped seven straight following losses to Delaware (2-0) and Drexel (3-2 in 2ot) last week. Freshman forward **Kaysi Ward** became the eighth different Towson player to score a goal this season when she gave her team a 2-1 lead in the 29th minute. Junior forward **Erica Marshall** ended the Tigers' streak of every goal being scored by a different player when she got her second goal versus Drexel. Marshall ranks seventh in career goals (13) and ninth in career points (31) at Towson. Senior keeper **Kendie Bauer** made a career-high 11 saves at Drexel, which was the most for a Towson player since 2006. The Tigers open a three-match homestand this week against ODU and William & Mary.

**VCU (8-7-1 overall, 4-3-1 in CAA):**

The Rams slid to sixth in the CAA standings after road losses at William & Mary (2-1) and Old Dominion (3-0). VCU took a 1-0 lead on the Tribe in the 63rd minute as **June Hartman** scored her fourth goal of the season. Senior **Stephanie Power** picked up her team-leading ninth assist on the play. The Rams held the lead through 86 minutes before W&M rallied for two goals in the final 3:12. VCU was limited to just five shots in the setback at ODU and put just one of them on net. Keeper **Kali Van Covern** made seven saves in 135 minutes of action last week. The Rams will try to bounce back this week when they host Hofstra and Northeastern.

**WILLIAM & MARY (11-5-1 overall, 6-2 in CAA):**

The Tribe rallied past VCU 2-1, but lost 1-0 in double overtime to James Madison to fall one point out of the lead in the CAA standings. William & Mary scored twice in the final 3:12 to get past VCU. Senior back **Abby Lauer** assisted on both goals, setting up **Claire Zimmeck** for the equalizer in the 87th minute before finding **Kellie Jenkins** for the game-winner with 1:26 remaining. Zimmeck's goal was her team-leading ninth of the year, while Jenkins' goal was her sixth. The Tribe out-shot JMU 16-11, but suffered their first home loss to a CAA opponent since Oct. 7, 2004. W&M's victory over the Rams was the 99th CAA triumph for coach **John Daly**. The game was played before a school-record 564 fans and a national TV audience on FOX Soccer Channel. W&M travels to George Mason and Towson this weekend.
